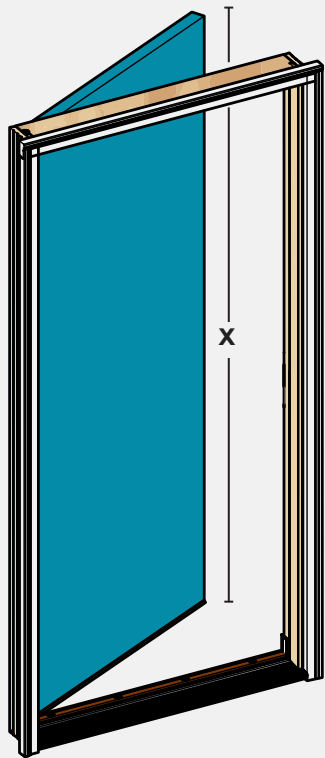


Lock Option Selection Guide
